

SALLYPORT AWARDED 3 YR FIRE FIGHTING CONTRACT AT COB BASRA, IRAQ BY U.S. ARMY

BRIDGEVILLE, PA. – April 12, 2009 – The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, Basra Regional Contracting Command has awarded Sallyport a 3 yr contract to provide fire and emergency management services (FEMS) at Contingency Operating Base (COB) Basrah located 20 minutes outside the city at the international airport. On May 1st, Sallyport will take over FEMS from the departing British military. The British military began handing over military command in Basra to U.S. forces last month. The project includes providing Expeditionary Fire Fighting (EFF) services, procurement of mission critical fire fighting equipment, the building of a new fire station and living compound for the fire fighters and training of its Iraqi fire fighter counterparts who are providing fire fighting services for the Basra International Airport.
